Conclusion of Forum e-Zdrowia

Being aware of the:

- complexity of preparing and implementing the ehealth,
- expressed needs and aspirations of Polish citizens for better and longer life ensuring of which necessitates the delivery of digital solutions in the areas such as:
 - o adaptation of the health care system for the new, digital life style,
 - o enlargement of the scope of health promotion, prevention and early disease detection,
 - o improvement of healthcare efficiency.

Forum Participants consider that:

Patientcentric health care system with its ehealth solutions described in WHO, UE, OECD documents should permanently identify changes and expectations in the health care needs and coordinate health care system to provide the best quality.

Key requirements of patientcentric healthcare system, such as a variety of stakeholders, outcomes, complexity of ehealth projects, lead to the conclusion that we should implement best practices from other countries, and in particular focus on:

- creating strategy and management in ehealth,
- solutions for the institutional structure and governance, regulations, organizations, technology and interoperability standards,
- implementation of ehealth solutions based on pilotage methods,
- development of staff competence,
- marketing of ehealth among patients.

Forum Participants:

- declare that within their competences and resources they are ready to participate in the
 activities on ehelath development in Poland,
- welcome with satisfaction the activity of the Center for Integrated Care and eHealth of Medical University of Gdansk for the identification and adaptation the ehealth international best practices in Poland,
- express hope that the conclusions of Forum will be considered by the Ministry of Health, Centre for Healthcare Information Systems, local governments and other stakeholders working for ehealth.
